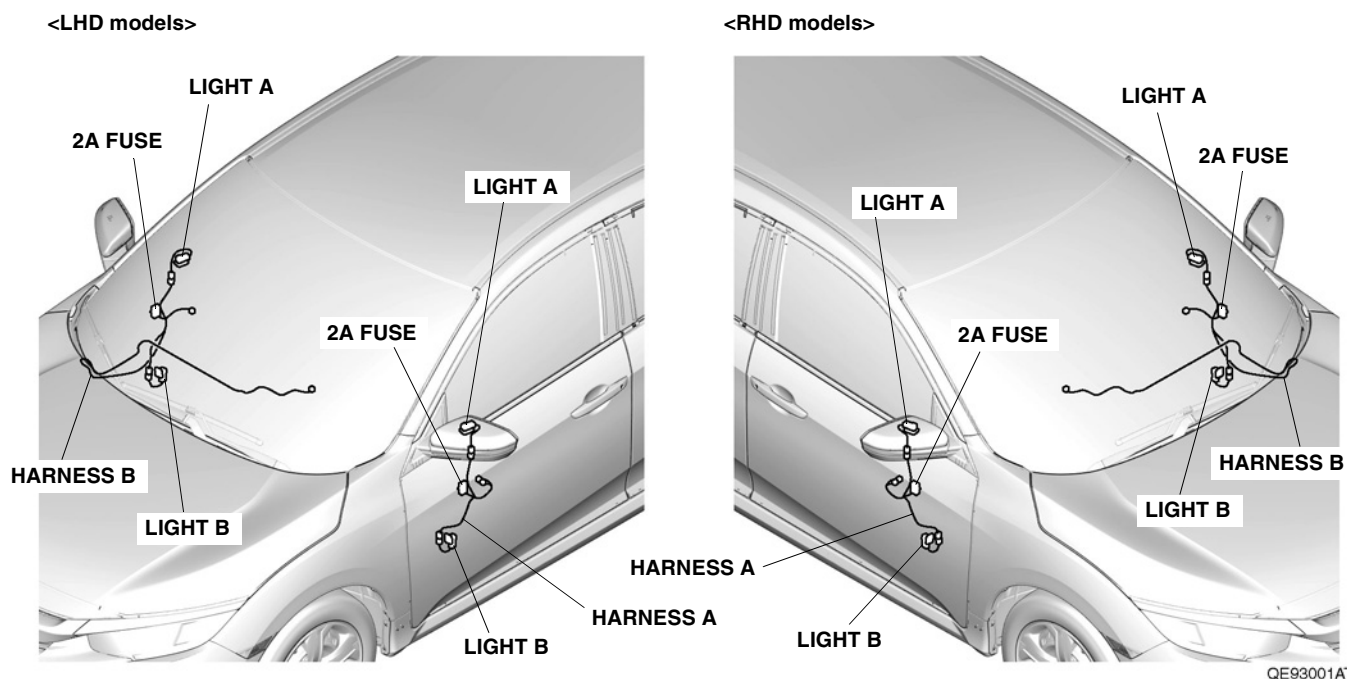

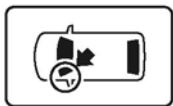

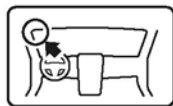

Tighten by specified torque.

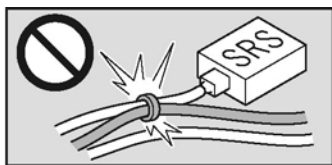

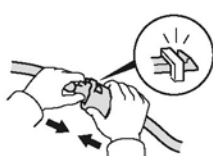

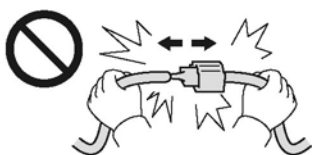
Wire Harness Routing Precaution



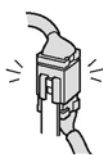
Do not clamp the

SRS harness together.



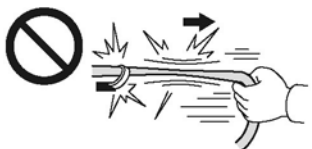
Connect the connectors

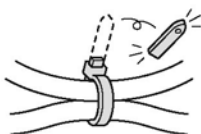

Safety: General

- Observe all safety notes and precautions described in the Shop Manual in addition to those described in this Installation Instructions. Be extremely careful for your safety and safety of others particularly.
- Be careful not to damage the vehicle and the parts.
- Be extremely careful to the handling of the retaining tabs and clips particularly.
- Note the locations of the parts before removing them so that they can be reinstalled in their original positions properly.







- Do not perform the installation of the accessories with having connected negative cable of the battery.

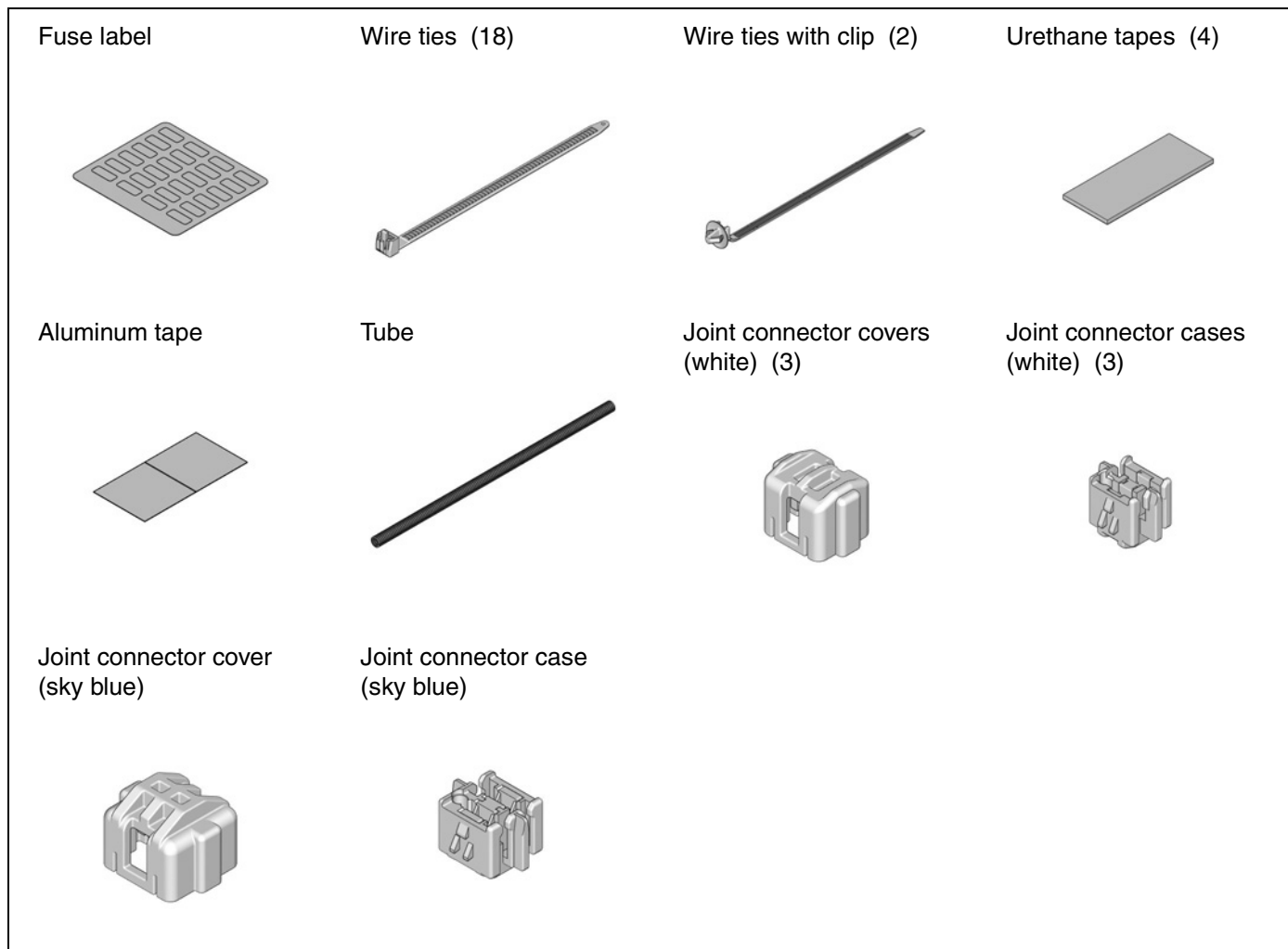
Safety: For the Accessory

- Always use the parts and tools specified in the installation instructions.
- Do not perform installation work and attaching work at the place where gets the direct rays of the sun or the dust appears.
- Always install these accessories at the ambient air temperature 15°C (60°F) or above.
- Heat the accessories and bonding surfaces if the ambient air temperature is below 15°C (60°F).
- Attach the accessories by pressing it firmly with the palm of your hand. Be careful not to damage the accessories and the vehicle parts.
- Carefully place the double-sided adhesive tape on the proper position. Once the double-sided adhesive tape touches the surface, do not try to detach and relocate it. If you attempt to move after it touches the surface, you will damage the part before the adhesive will give way.

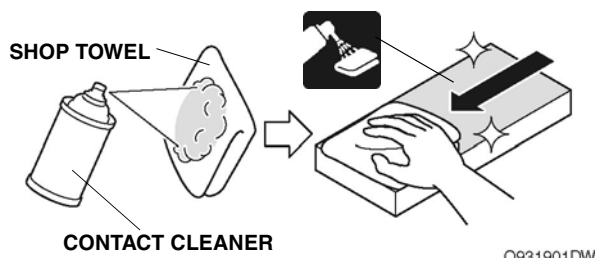

How to Use the Contact Cleaner

- Using contact cleaner on a shop towel, thoroughly clean the areas where the accessories will be attached.

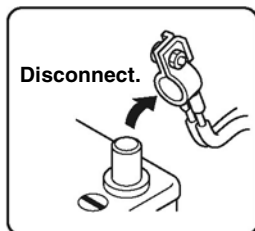
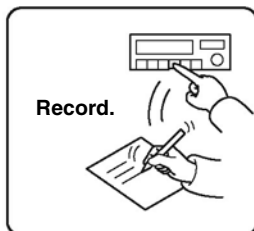
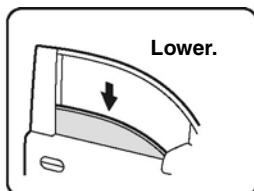
NOTICE

- Do not apply the cleaner to the object of the work directly.
- Completely dry the cleaned areas before attachment work.



Disconnecting the Battery Cable

1. Perform the works before disconnecting the negative cable from the battery as shown below.
2. Make sure if you have the anti-theft code for the audio/navigation system. Record some settings of the vehicle if necessary.
3. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery.

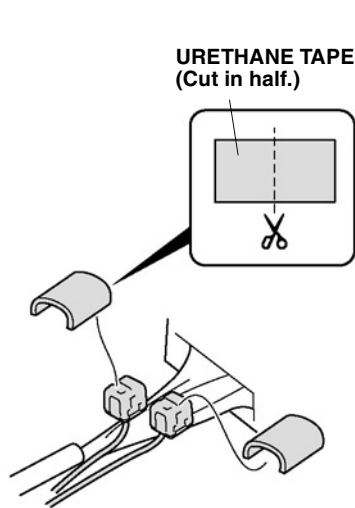

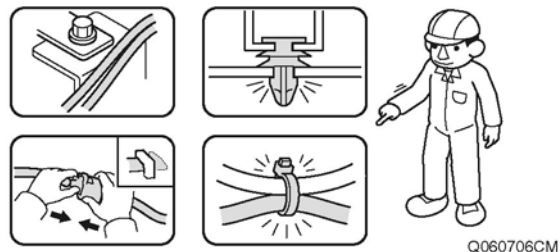


Check After Installation

118. Check that all parts are routed and installed properly.

NOTICE

- Check that the harnesses are not pushed, not pulled and not pinched.
- Check that all clamps and wire ties are installed securely.

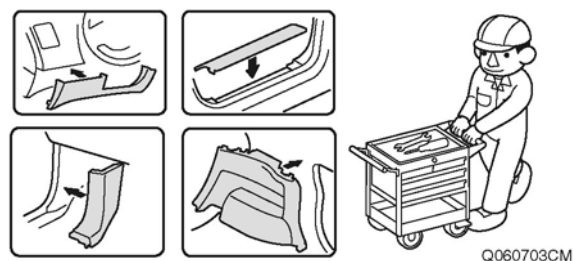


Reinstalling the All Removed Parts

119. Reinstall all removed parts.

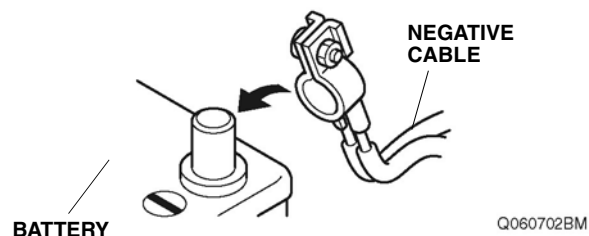
NOTICE

- Be extremely careful not to damage the vehicle parts, pinch the harnesses.
- Make sure to secure the retaining tabs and clips properly to avoid separation.



Operation Check

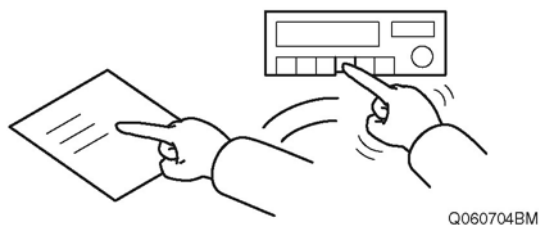
120. Reconnect the negative cable to the battery.



121. Turn the engine switch to ON; the SRS indicator should come on for about 6 seconds and then go off.
122. Turn the engine switch to ON, check that the light comes on.

Vehicle Check

123. Check that the electric accessories and systems operate properly.
124. Press and hold the audio power button for two seconds, or enter anti-theft code for the audio/navigation system.
125. Reset the memory of each equipment and restore the positions of those control knobs.
